## The Museum is Moving!

The Angola Museum was offered an amazing opportunity last year in the form of a proposal to move to the campus of the old Tunica Elementary School, which is owned by the Louisiana Department of Public Safety & Corrections. This facility will allow us to create a more in-depth and interactive experience. Our goal is to create a meaningful institution that is better able to provide more transparent educational experiences and resources for our community, based around the history of the prison's transformation from a plantation into the Louisiana State Penitentiary, its expansion to satellite prisons across Louisiana. We also plan to incorporate history and culture of the local area.

We also hope to create more space to host community based events and pop up exhibitions with the goal of helping to further express and educate about this history and the current state of Louisiana's criminal justice system. the future of Louisiana corrections and criminal justice reforms.
